

### **PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: Residential Treatment**


Each child who lives at St. Joe's today has experienced multiple forms of trauma, including but not limited to homelessness, malnutrition, emotional abuse, physical abuse, sexual abuse, and neglect. The overall goal of this program is to prepare the children to be in a home again, and our outcomes reflect that when a child leaves St. Joe's, they join a safe and loving family.

St. Joe's may house up to 48 children at a time and served 87 children total in 2019.



# PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: Therapeutic Foster Care & Adoption

There is a crisis of child maltreatment in Kentucky, as the state is currently ranked #1 in the nation for child abuse and neglect. As a result, an overwhelming number of Kentucky's children are placed in the state's foster care system after being removed from their homes due to significant trauma. At St. Joe's, it is our privilege to connect a child with the right family, whether it is only temporary or their forever adoptive family.



We believe children develop into strong, independent, self-confident individuals when given the proper opportunities to stimulate their growth socially, emotionally, physically and intellectually. We provide your child a warm environment, filled with love, good physical care and an atmosphere for learning.






